Nicely textural with pronounced peach & apricot notes, finishing with lime & spices.
44. Macon Villages, 2015, Domaine Mathias, Burgundy, France 33
Upfront & full with a hint of buttery shortbread & hazelnuts balanced by green apple acidity.
45. Chardonnay Reserve, 2016, Saint Marc, Languedoc, France 22
Aromas of butter & almonds, with intense ripe citrus fruit flavours.
46. Pouilly Fuissé “Des Roches”, 2014, Jacques Simonin, Burgundy, France 43.5
Powerful, yet medium bodied white, intense palate of hazelnuts, lemon & spice, very elegant finish.
47. Petit Chablis, 2015, Domaine Louis Robin, Burgundy, France 35
Fresh & flinty on the nose with creamy fruit character, rich & gently mineral.
48. Chablis 1er Cru “Vaucopin”, 2015, Domaine Louis Robin, Burgundy, France 52
Light oak & ripe citrus fruits on the nose, wonderful aromas of baked apple, textured & full flavoured with an impressive complexity, richness & depth of flavour.

Perfumed & fruity, with wild flowers aromas & cherry fruit flavours & an elegant finish.
63. Pinot Noir “Le Versant”, 2015, Languedoc, France 27.5
Intense notes of raspberries & stewed cherries with silky tannins & fine structure.
64. Nielson Pinot Noir, 2014, Byron Vineyards, Santa Barbara, California 48
Gloriously fruity with refreshing sour cherry & wild strawberry notes, very complex & earthy.
65. Crossings Estate Pinot Noir, 2015, Marlborough, New Zealand 39.5
Pure lifted forest fruits with dusky spice, juiciness & a ripe elegant medium body.
66. Marsannay “St Jacques”, 2004, Fougerey de Beauclair, Burgundy, France 59
Fine & mature classic red Burgundy, lightly smoky, with sweet & sour red fruits & fine elegant structure.
67. Auxey Duresses 1er Cru “La Chapelle”, 2006, Henri Latour, Burgundy, Fr 65
Silky & gently powerful exhibiting layers of redcurrant & cherry fruit flavours & toasty notes.

68. Cabernet Sauvignon, 2015, Van Zijl Family, South Africa 26
Intense & bright, succulent dark berry fruits, soft & rounded chocolate mouth feel.
69. Côtes du Rhône Vieilles Vignes, 2016, “Cuvée Princes d’Orange”, France 32
Made from 40 years old vines, complex aromas of blackberries & brambles, full body with spicy tannins.
70. Malbec, 2017, Para Dos, San Juan, Argentina 26
Mixed spices & bramble fruit character, dark damson & savoury overtones on the palate.
71. Malbec “Cuvée Armandiere”, 2014, Château Armandiere, Cahors, France 34.5
From the original home of Malbec - intense plum & blackberry notes, lovely spice & complexity.
72. Shiraz, 2017, Soldiers Block, Langhorne Creek, Australia 29.5
Bright & lifted Shiraz, perfumed dusty notes of dark fruit, vanilla & spice.
73. Barbera “Le Croci Single Vineyard”, 2014, Piedmont, Italy 39.5
Ripe & savoury, with black fruits & lightly gamey notes, intense & having a real depth.
74. Châteauneuf-du-Pape, 2015, Jean-Pierre Boisson, Rhône Valley, France 52
Classic notes of herbs & cedar, very concentrated, intense, fragrant & savoury.

Soft & aromatic with comforting & generous character & vibrant finish.
77. Rioja Reserva "Distercio", 2011, Bodega Florentino Martinez, Spain 42
Deep dark fruit flavours combined with exquisite savoury & spicy character, smooth tannins.
78. Primitivo del Salento, 2016, Poggio Arduini, Italy 23.5
A medium bodied red with aromas of plums & juicy fresh cherries.
79. Barolo, 2013, Cantine Neirano, Piedmont, Italy 53.5
Dark plum, leather & spices, full bodied with firm & ripe texture & a good lengthy finish.
80. Sula Vineyards Shiraz, 2016, Nashik, India 34
Deep purple colour with attractive notes of blackberries, dark chocolate & vanilla.
81. Amarone "La Colombaia", 2014, Giacomo Montesor, Veneto, Italy 69
Ripe, warm & generous, with hints of dark chocolate & black cherries, supple tannins & spicy finish.

82. Grenache, 2013, Domaine de Boissan, Ventoux, France 26
Subtle & enticing, combining well black cherries, wild herbs, spice & vanilla notes.
83. Château Durand Laplagne, 2012, Puisseguin St Émilion, Bordeaux, France 34
Rich & harmonious, with great intensity & powerful velvety notes of spiced crushed red fruits.
84. Organic Carménere Reserva, 2015, Adobe, Colchagua Valley, Chile 26.5
Lively aromas of cherries & black pepper, well balanced with smooth fruity flavours.
85. Merlot Reserve, 2016, Saint Marc, Languedoc, France 23.5
Deep purple colour, blackcurrant fruit, round & juicy, soft finish.
86. Gigondas Vieilles Vignes, 2013, Domaine Boissan, Rhône Valley, France 45
Deep coloured & intense, black cherries, dark chocolate notes, firm, spicy & weighty.
87. Château Giraudels Milon, 2006, St Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France 62
Spicy plum & blackberry, with toasty oak, black cherries, hints of coffee, full bodied & smooth.
88. Château Tayac, 2013, Famille Portet, Margaux, Bordeaux, France 75
Fine structure with aromas of bramble, sandalwood & forest fruits, medium bodied with firm tannins.

WHITE

100. Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc, 2017, Marlborough, New Zealand 62
Established in 1985 in the Wairau Valley in Marlborough, possibly the most prestigious Sauvignon Blanc in the world, it definitely lives up to its reputation. A wine full of fresh herbal aromas & layers of ripe guava & tropical fruit. Gooseberries & passion fruit on the medium-full body, the palate is succulent & crisp with a long finish.
101. Meursault "Les Vireuils", 2016, Domaine Henri Latour, Burgundy, France 75
This Meursault is elegant & mineral with great textural intensity, a broad creamy palate with savoury butter & toasty notes balanced by a racy & vivacious finish. New oak is restricted to around 25% to ensure it does not mask the pure, elegant style. Outstanding white Burgundy from a superb producer.
102. Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru "Les Folatières, 2014, Domaine Jean-Louis Chavy, Burgundy, France 97
The vineyards of this Puligny are over 45 years old & come from the village's finest 1er Cru vineyard Les Folatières. The deep stony soil gives the wine great intensity & elegance with floral aromas, hints of almond & hazelnut combined with richness, depth & intense minerality & spice from well-judged use of oak.
103. Corton Charlemagne Grand Cru, 2008, Dom Michel Juillot, Burgundy, France 140
From the most prestigious appellation for white Burgundy, the renowned Michel Juillot makes this Grand Cru from a 50-years-old vineyard of 100% Chardonnay that is matured for 12 months in oak barrels. The wine exhibits a complex bouquet of chamomile, butterscotch, hazelnuts & cream, the finish is impressively oaked with great, clean length. This Corton Charlemagne shows an amazing structure & is without a doubt wine to remember.

ROSE

105. Domaines Ott "Clos de Mireille", 2016, Provence Cru Classé, France 68
Founded in 1896 Domaines Ott uses hand picking, careful sorting & delicate pressing of the traditional Provence grapes of Grenache, Cinsault & Syrah to make what is known as the best rosé in the world. Aromas of white stone fruits, minerals & brioche open to a palate that is dry & well-balanced with delicate peach flavours & hints of sweet orange citrus.

RED

110. Rubicon, 2014, Meerlust Estate, Stellenbosch, South Africa 70
An iconic red Bordeaux blend from South Africa composed of 67% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Merlot, 12% Cabernet Franc & 7% Petit Verdot. Opulent nose bursting with blueberry pie, vanilla pod spice, violets & cedar wood. Very impressive with lifted black currant & raisined cranberry notes, the complexity of Rubicon is mesmerising, having spent 20 months in 67% new French Nevers oak with 33% 2nd fill Nevers & Alliers barrels.
111. Brunello di Montalcino, 2013, Campo Giovanni, Tuscany, Italy 95
A premium Brunello with aromas of well-ripened wild berry fruit, plum, tobacco leaf & tanned leather. An expansive, generous palate displays rich fruit & mouthfeel with fine-grained tannins - developing into a long, persistent & fruit-filled finish with notes of graphite. Matured for 36 months in large Slavonian oak botti casks.
112. Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru "Lavaux St Jacques", 2014, Domaine Tortochot, 120Burgundy, France
From one of the most famous single vineyards "Lavaux St Jacques" in Burgundy, this is very intense, gently spicy & lightly perfumed, with exceptionally ripe Pinot Noir fruit with shades of nutmeg & cinnamon. The palate is silky smooth & richly textured. Finishing with nice warmth, charm & exquisite structure.
113. Château Talbot, 2006, Saint-Julien 4eme Cru Classé, Bordeaux, France 165
One of the best known Bordeaux wine estates, the 2006 Talbot is dense ruby, with moderate intense notes of forest floor, underbrush and black & redcurrant fruit. It is medium bodied with supple tannins & well-judged acidity, exhibiting notes of sweet herbs, liquorice, black cherries & smoked game, complex & very long finish.
